“Trader loses ₹1.57L to cyber crooks while in bank”

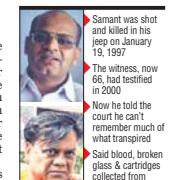

Samant was shot and killed in his 1997 on January 19, 1997. The witness, now 66, had testified in 2010. Now he told the court he can't remember much of what transpired. Said blood, broken glass & cartridges collected from crime scene

At the time Rajan was absconding accused. After Chhota Rajan's extradition from Bali (Indonesia), the central agency had taken over the case. It had filed a supplementary chargesheet against the gangster, now lodged in the high-security Thirar jail.
